

## Schedule 2 - List of permitted wastes

**Table S2.1 Permitted waste types and quantities for the use of waste in construction**

Maximum quantity The total quantity of waste accepted at the site shall be less than 210,000 tonnes per year.

### Exclusions

Wastes having any of the following characteristics shall not be accepted:

- consisting solely or mainly of dusts, powders or loose fibres
- hazardous wastes
- wastes in liquid form
